

Terms & Conditions

1. Wooden Spoon values your support and promises to respect your privacy.  2. Information on how to enter form part of these conditions of entry ("the **Conditions of Entry**"). By entering into this Competition, you agree to be bound by these Conditions of Entry.
 3. The Competition will open on Tuesday 12 March at 09:00 GMT and will close on Monday 29th April 2019 at 23:59 GMT (the "**Competition Period**").
 4. Entries received outside the Competition Period will not be valid. We do not accept any responsibility for entries that are lost or delayed for any reason. Submission of an entry will not be proof of receipt and no responsibility will be accepted for entries that we do not receive. Illegible or incomplete entries will be disqualified.
 5. Competition entry is open to residents of the United Kingdom and Ireland aged 18 or over only ("**Eligible Entrants**"), excluding directors, management, employees and their immediate families of Wooden Spoon and its agencies associated with this Competition.

 7. No purchase is necessary to enter the Competition however the text will incur an optional £5 donation to Wooden Spoon. You have the option to cancel the donation with 10 minutes of sending the text.
 8. The winner will be selected at random in the week after the competition period closes, and must ensure they meet the competition criteria stated above. The prize will be a rugby ball signed by our Everest Team Captains – Shane Williams, Lee Mears, Tamara Taylor and Ollie Phillips.
